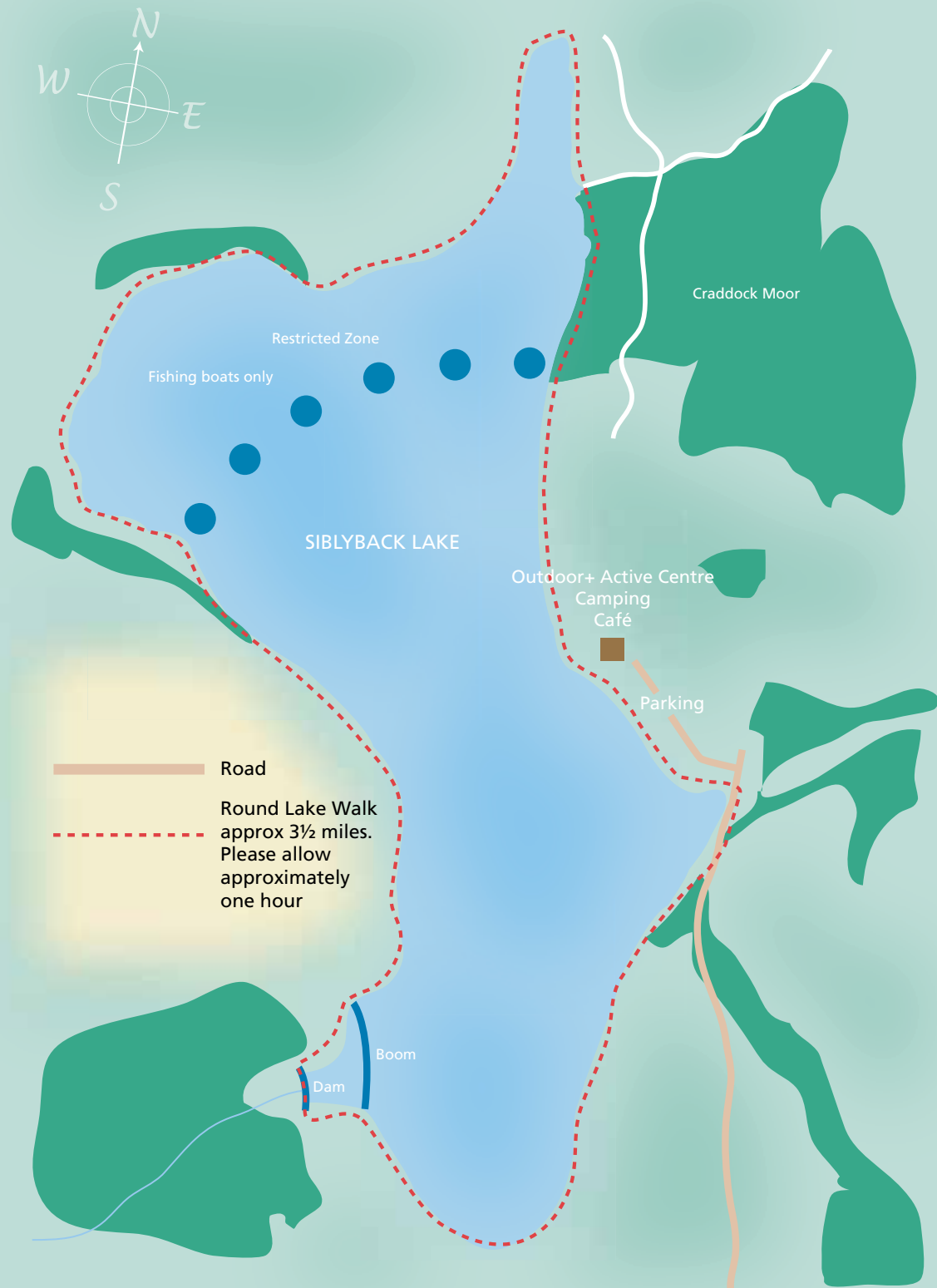
From the A30 take the Bolventor junction, from Jamaica Inn follow road signs to Siblyback Lake.

It is recommended that you check with the Centre prior to travelling that the equipment you wish to hire is available.

Self Launch

Own dinghy, kayak, windsurf, rowing boats welcome for a launch fee.

You must have third party insurance and your craft should not exceed 18ft in length. Please note we do not offer facilities for the launch of powered craft.

Launch Membership

Become a Member and receive discounts on camping, and adult courses.

Membership runs from 1 April. Includes limited safety boat cover and is transferable between sites.

Trout Angling

at Siblyback Lake Country Park

Anglers will be in their element at this nationally renowned stocked rainbow trout Lake, one of our three premier trout fisheries, set in peaceful and tranquil surroundings. Siblyback Lake is a Trout Master fishery.

Stocked regularly with rainbow trout averaging up to 6lb, it recorded excellent results in 2009, with a rod average of 3 fish per angler. Siblyback offers facilities for both boat and bank angling. The fishery record stands at a rainbow trout of 10lb 8oz.

Please note that fly fishing is the only method permitted, and that all anglers over 12 years must possess a valid Environment Agency rod licence.

A full day permit costs £20, with a concessionary rate of £16.50. Under 16s can fish for just £4 while under 12s may fish for free, providing they are fishing with a parent or guardian, and share the adult's bag limit.

Permits are available from the Trout Fishing Centre. We have a fleet of boats for angling. To guarantee a boat, booking on 01579 346522 at least 24 hours in advance is essential. Day and season permits can be purchased on site (Boats not always available seven days per week), or book online at swlakestrust.org.uk.

We also have a Wheelyboat available for hire. Wheelyboats provide easy access to the water for people with disabilities, particularly for those using a wheelchair. The boat does require advance booking.

The Trust often runs angling tuition days in conjunction with the Environment Agency. Look out for posters on site, visit our website swlakestrust.org.uk or contact the Centre for future dates.
